Categories:

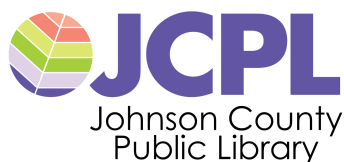
Grades 6-9 • Grades 10-12 • People's Choice

- Artwork must be original. Previously published designs or copyrighted figures (ex: Disney) will not be accepted.
- Entries should be brought to a JCPL Branch between Nov. 1-Dec. 2, 2022. Winners will be announced in early January.
- There are three categories: grades 6-9, grades 10-12 and People's Choice. Prizes will be awarded in each category.
- Artwork should be mounted onto a matte board or another sturdy background.
- Artwork should be no larger than 46" W X 36" H.
- Only one piece per person may be submitted.
- All submissions will be displayed at the Clark Pleasant Branch on Saturday, Jan. 7, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Teen Art Contest Reception. All artists are invited to attend to showcase their submissions.
- JCPL is not responsible for any damage incurred while on display.
- Artwork must be picked up at the reception. If you are unable to attend, please contact kstaten@jcplin.org to schedule a pick-up time.
- JCPL reserves the right to photograph and video artists and artwork and to invite the media to do the same.
- By entering you grant JCPL the right to use your work for promotional purposes without fee or other compensation.
- All work must be appropriate for viewing by the general public, including children. No work with offensive content (as determined by the contest organizers) will be eligible.
