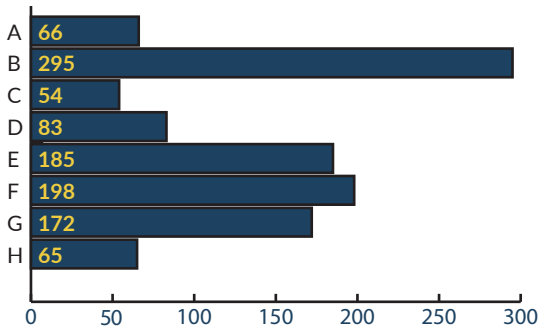

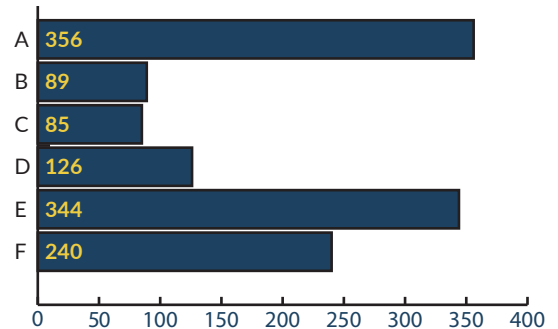

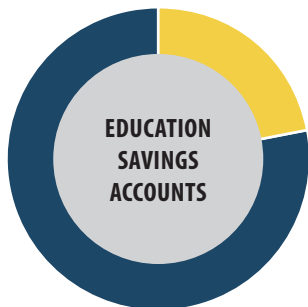
2. What aspect of your life has been the most strained by the COVID-19 pandemic?

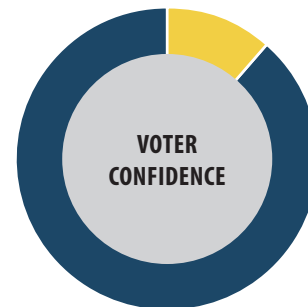


3. Do you support or oppose giving parents of special-needs children the option to use state educational funding for services such as private school tuition and developmental therapy?

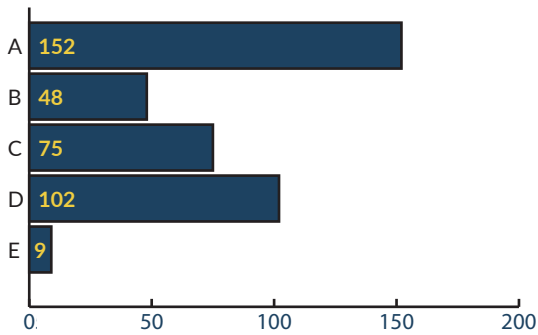

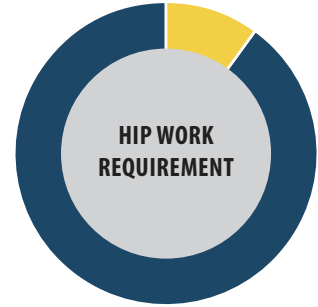
6. Regarding health care, which one of the following is the most important to you?
