And then the smiles began to pop all around as awards totalling \$141,737 were distributed, including distributions from two of our Donor Advised funds. Thank you to our generous donors who make it all possible!

Animal Welfare League

Misha Anderson from AWL accepts the grant award - funds will be used for modifications to dog runs, installation of a fire safety monitoring system, and furnace repairs.
