
As a state senator, Messmer represents Senate District 48, which includes Crawford, Dubois, Gibson, Perry, Pike and Spencer counties.

Professionally, Messmer is the co-owner of Messmer Mechanical, Inc., and holds a bachelor's degree from Purdue University in mechanical engineering.
