The Hillenbrand Community Leadership Series (HICLS) engages with key leaders from the company and community in strategic discussions focusing on continuing to build our community into an attractive place to live and work. This group of twenty will have the opportunity to listen to a variety of speakers around a central theme. This year's theme is, **"Building Regional Capacity"**. The focus of the class will be expanding thought of how we approach micro-regionalism in rural communities. During this series, you will hear from guest speakers who will all address key aspects surrounding the theme.

Over the course of the year, the class will meet four times around a central theme of building regional capacity.
