How to Enter




Contest Dates:

Artwork may be submitted November 2-December 1, 2019 by 5 p.m. The top three winners in each age category (grades 6-9 and grades 10-12) will win a prize. Winners will be announced in January.

All submissions will be on display at the Franklin Branch from 2-4 p.m. on Saturday, January 11. All artists are invited to attend to showcase their submissions.

ENTRY INFORMATION

- Entries should be brought to one of the JCPL branches from Nov. 2-Dec. 1, 2019 by 5 p.m. Winners will be announced in early January.
- There are two grade categories: grades 6-9 and grades 10-12. The top three winners in each category will win a prize.
- Artwork should be mounted onto matte board or other sturdy background.
- Artwork should be no larger than 46"W X 36" T.
- Only one piece per person may be submitted.
- All work must be appropriate for view by the general public, including children. No work with offensive content (as determined by contest organizers) will be eligible.

TEEN ART CONTEST RECEPTION

- All submissions will be on display at the Franklin Branch from 2-4 p.m. on Sat, Jan. 11, for the Teen Art Contest Reception. All artists are invited to attend to showcase their submissions.

ARTWORK PICKUP INFORMATION

- Artwork may be picked up at the Teen Art Contest Reception on Saturday, Jan. 11 from 2-4 p.m. If you are unable to attend, please call Kelly Staten at the Franklin Branch (317-738-2833) to arrange a date/time for pick-up. Submissions will be held for three months and then the library has the right to discard if artwork is not picked up.

JUDGING

- Creative Council of Franklin will judge again this year. Winners will be announced in early January.

- JCPL reserves the right to photograph and video artists and artwork, and to invite the media to do the same.
