



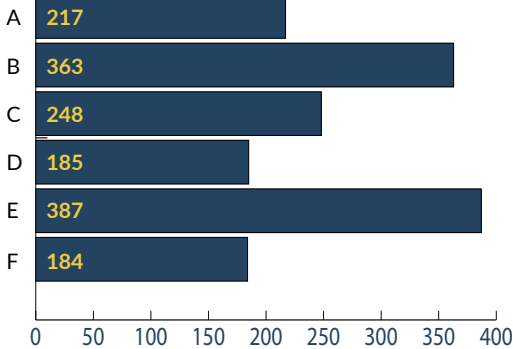

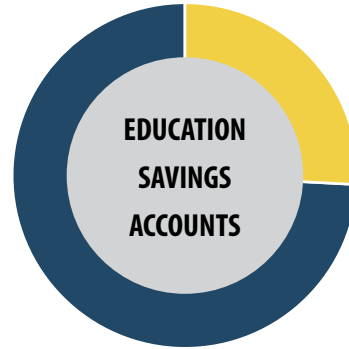
1. When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

- F) Other



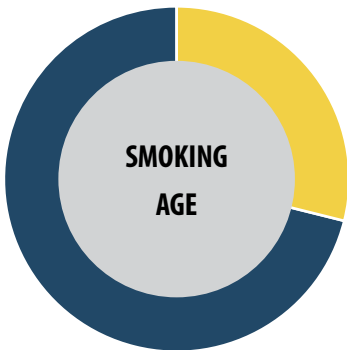
2. Do you support or oppose giving parents of special-needs children the option to use state educational funding for services such as private-school tuition and developmental therapy?

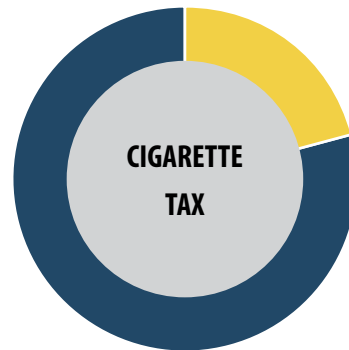
3. The minimum legal age to buy cigarettes in Indiana is currently 18. Do you support or oppose raising the smoking age to 21?

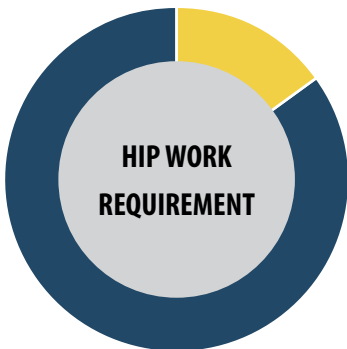
4. Do you support or oppose raising Indiana's cigarette tax by \$1.50 per pack in order to deter smoking and pay for health programs?
