This debrief facilitation guide should be used either directly following the chapters service event or at the next chapter meeting.

OBJECTIVES

- Participants will be able to articulate what the service event meant to them personally.
- Participants will reflect on how community needs, can be serviced. The tutoring program consists of three
 areas: academic mentors for each new member, the brothers helping brothers program, and university
 tutoring assistance. Each of these programs is designed to ensure that any member or associate member
 that is experiencing difficulties with his academic performance, receives immediate assistance.

	How can you apply this learning back to your life?
	What can we do as a chapter to better serve the community moving forward?
	How can we hope to improve this service event in the future?
