68%

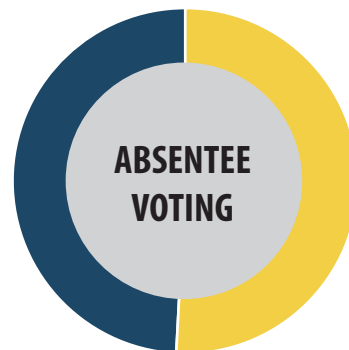
**3.** Hoosiers currently must register about a month before Election Day in order to vote. Should the law be changed so you can both register and vote on Election Day?

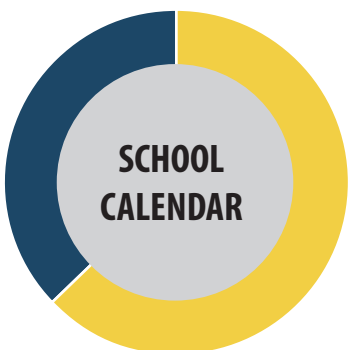
