

The following charts represent responses to the multiple-choice questions offered on my mailed and online survey.


Which one of the following do you feel would do most to improve K-12 education in Indiana?

## **IMPROVE K-12 EDUCATION**



**2.** Do you support or oppose the following statement? Parents should be given more opportunities to choose the best school for their child, whether that be public, private, religious or charter school.




