


- When the legislature adopts a new state budget during

 - F) Other




Do you support or oppose giving schools the ability to propose property-tax referendums specifically to pay for school safety improvements?





Should Indiana legalize marijuana for medical use?












- Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded healthcare coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?
