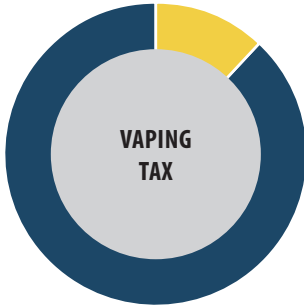

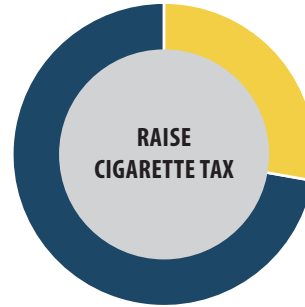
1. Should Indiana place a tax on vaping products similar to the tax that is currently placed on cigarettes?

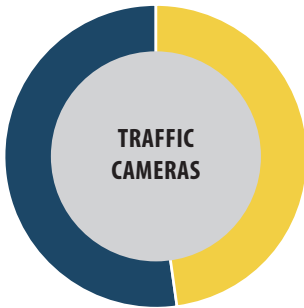
2. Should Indiana increase its tax on cigarettes by \$2 per pack to deter smoking and help fund health care programs?

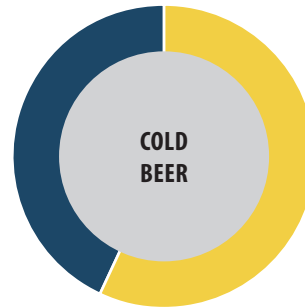
3. In order to increase highway work-zone safety, should cameras be used to issue tickets to drivers who speed in work zones?

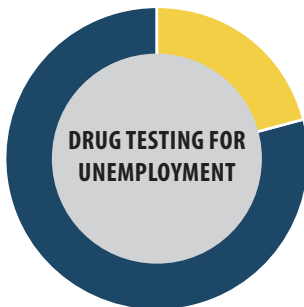
4. Do you support or oppose allowing licensed retail stores, including gas stations, to sell cold beer for carryout? (This is currently limited to liquor stores.)

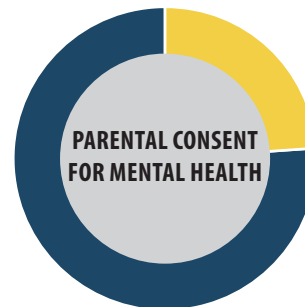
5. Do you support or oppose drug testing recipients of unemployment insurance?

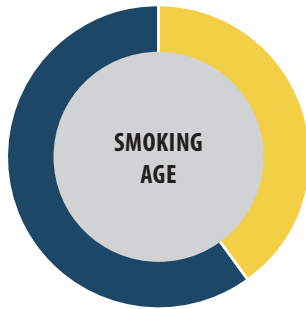

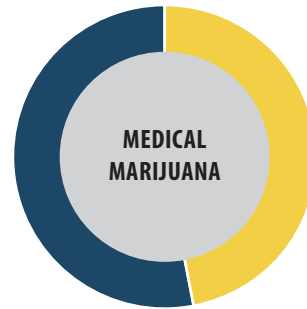

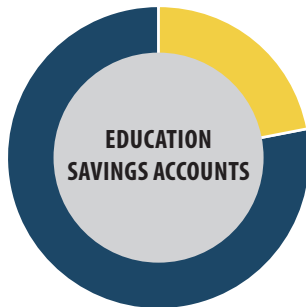

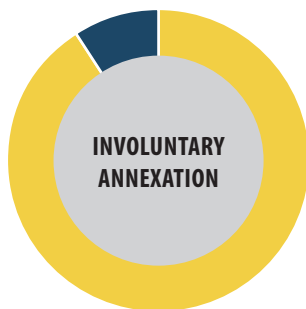
10. Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded health care coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?

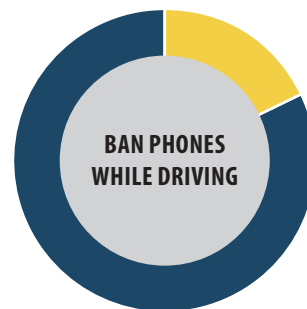
11. Do you believe cities and towns should be able to annex land without the support of a majority of the affected taxpayers?
