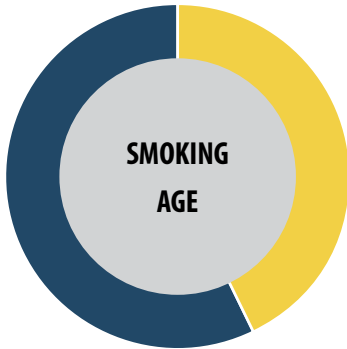

## STATE SENATOR CHIP PERFECT

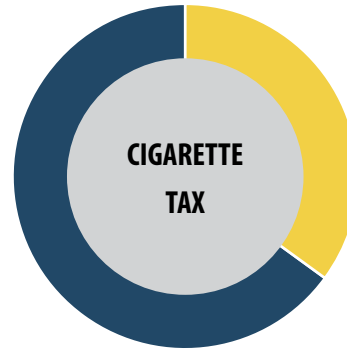
- 1.** The minimum legal age to buy cigarettes in Indiana is currently 18. Do you support or oppose raising the smoking age to 21?

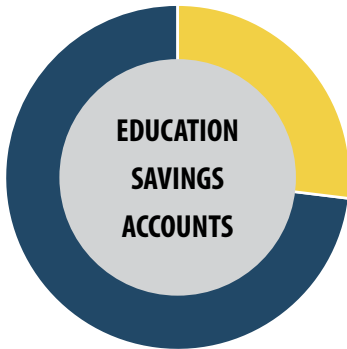
- 2.** Do you support or oppose raising Indiana's cigarette tax by \$1.50 per pack in order to deter smoking and pay for health programs?

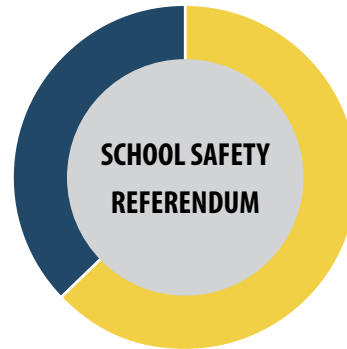
- 3.** Do you support or oppose giving parents of special-needs children the option to use state educational funding for services such as private-school tuition and developmental therapy?

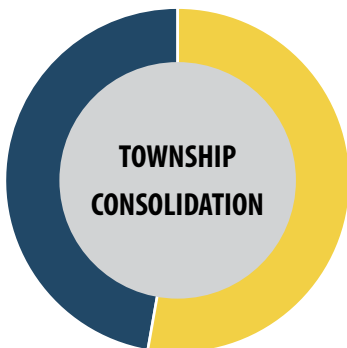
- 4.** Do you support or oppose giving schools the ability to propose property-tax referendums specifically to pay for school safety improvements?

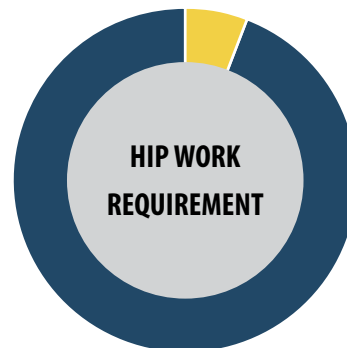
- 5.** Do you support or oppose requiring townships with fewer than 1,000 residents to consolidate in order to make local government more efficient?

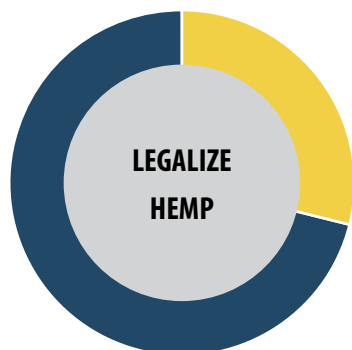
