



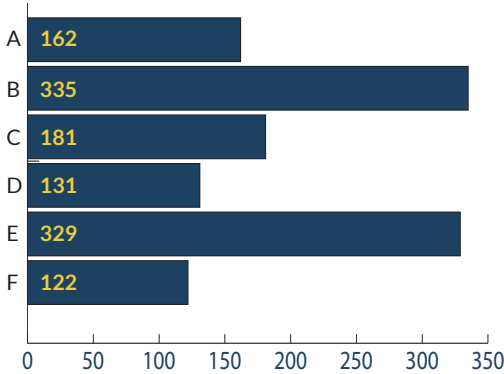

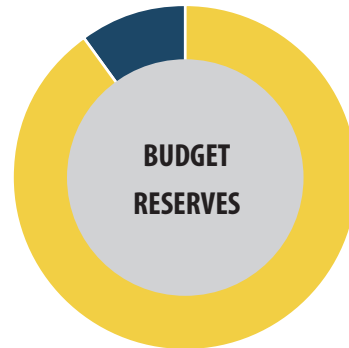
1. When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

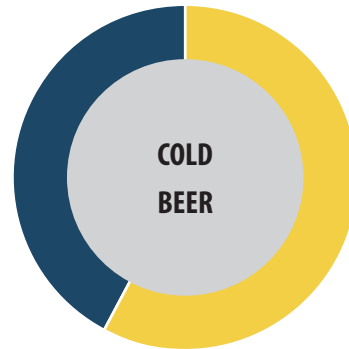
3. Do you support or oppose giving schools the ability to propose property-tax referendums specifically to pay for school safety improvements?

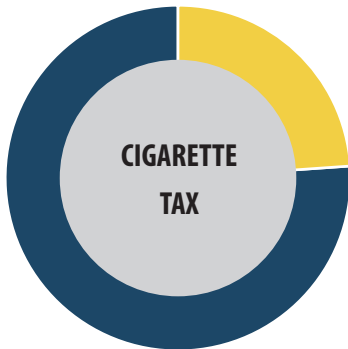

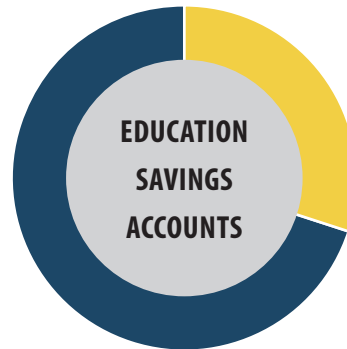
6. Do you support or oppose raising Indiana’s cigarette tax by \$1.50 per pack in order to deter smoking and pay for health programs?

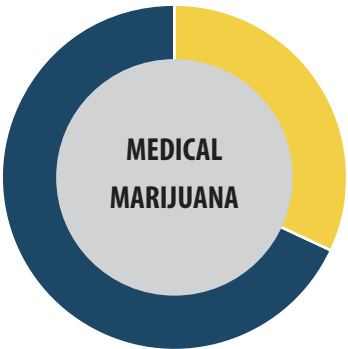
7. Do you support or oppose giving parents of special-needs children the option to use state educational funding for services such as private-school tuition and developmental therapy?
