



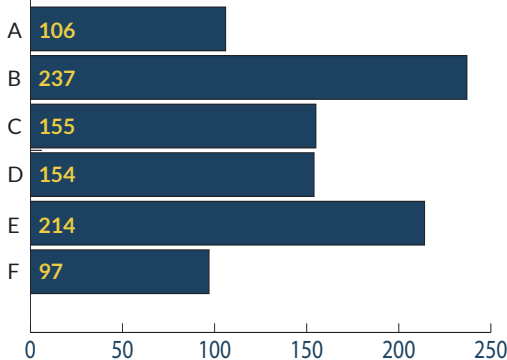

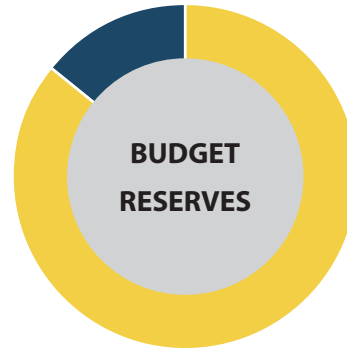
- 1.** When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

 F) Other



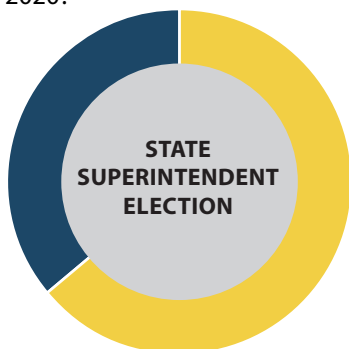

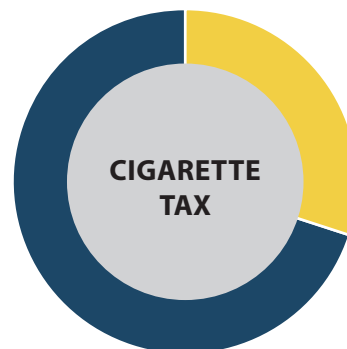

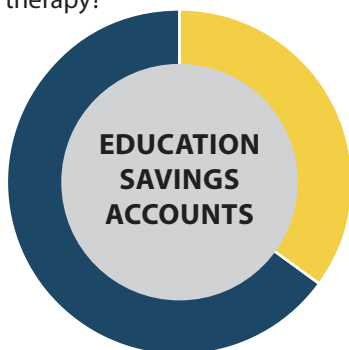
- 4.** Do you support or oppose raising Indiana's cigarette tax by \$1.50 per pack in order to deter smoking and pay for health programs?
