Leadership Johnson County values the work that we - as a community - can accomplish by working together. Throughout our existence, LJC has strived to engage with other organizations, nonprofits and people within Johnson County to provide continuing education opportunities to keep our community moving forward.

While leadership skills are imperative for an organization to move forward, especially in these economic times, education dollars are non-existent for many small business owners and non-profit organizations. Through a partnership with the Johnson County Community Foundation, LJC offers the nonprofit community a low-cost learning opportunity through "Nurturing Nonprofits." Additionally, LJC and JCCF have worked together to provide free Myers Briggs Type Indicator (MBTI) training to nonprofit organizations in Johnson County.



A collaborative effort between the Franklin Chamber, Greenwood Chamber, Johnson County Community Foundation and LJC addresses the need for businesses to keep up-to-date on the best practices in leadership through our series "Learn 2 Lead."

LJC partners with the Johnson County Development Corporation to present "Leaders In Motion," which features a local business presenting best practices and offering a tour of their facility.

Since its inception, LJC has worked with Franklin College to develop, implement and sustain our program. Led by Franklin College Leadership Department Chair and Director of LJC Curriculum, Bonnie Pribush, this partnership has blossomed over the years to help our community better engage with college students.




