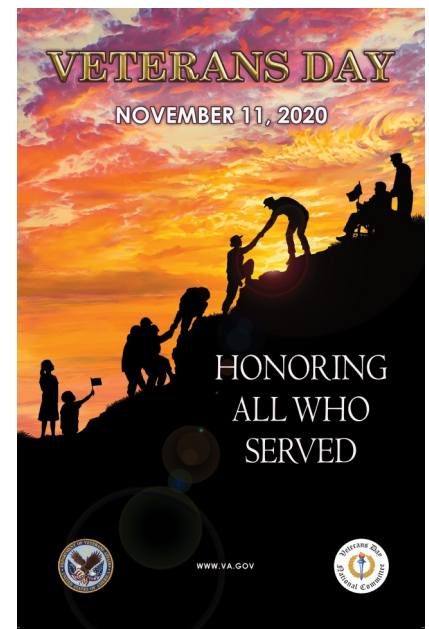

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PROOF OF RESIDENCY

The Indiana Department of Education is asking school districts to have on hand proof of residency for each student enrolled in their school(s). In order for our district to meet this request, we are asking families to scan or take a picture of a utility bill, internet and satellite television bill, or other like information that provides a verifiable address. Private account information should be marked out. A parent or guardian should send the picture or scan of their document to the applicable email addresses below. Include the student’s name and grade in the body of the email:

If your family has multiple students enrolled, please send the email to all buildings that apply and include all student’s names. Your scan or picture will be printed and placed in the student’s permanent record.
