 - c. Complete a pathway at Indian Creek high school and earn a C- or higher
 - d. Meet SAT Benchmark scores EBRW 480 Math 530

Empower Requirements

- GPA requirement is a 2.7
- MANDATORY student and parent meeting at the end of the 24-25 school year for all students in ALL empower courses for the 25-26 school year. If you do not attend, you will be removed from empower courses.
- No more than 10 unexcused absences in the 24-25 school year.
- MUST fill out an application in order to be considered.
- If you have an F in your empower course you must schedule a meeting with your teacher and counselor. You will also not be able to leave for the ENTIRE week if you have an F in the course.
- Disciplinary action will be taken if you have and F and leave the school building.
- Students are able to take only ONE empower course. Two empower courses can be considered if there is teacher approval from both empower teachers.
- If a student fails the first semester of an empower course, they will automatically be withdrawn from the second semester of a course.
- If a student is failing within the first 2 weeks of a course (within the drop deadline) they will automatically be removed from the course.
- Juniors and seniors ONLY
- ALL courses will be capped at 25 students. Once empower is at the 25 student limit, no one else will be added to the course.

6 Semester Graduation

- ★ Application deadline: Friday, February 14th.
- ★ Be on track to complete all credits for a Core 40 or Honors diploma with a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- ★ Meet the requirements for a graduation pathway
- ★ Complete a 6 semester graduation application
- ★ Complete a typed essay explaining why you want to graduate early (1-2 pages in length)
- ★ If approved, English 11 must be taken over the summer and English 12 must be taken in the classroom during junior year.
- ★ One or more of the criteria may be waived at administrator discretion or through case conference committee decision
- ★ The School Board will approve or deny all six semester graduation applications once administrator approval has been given

Timeline

- Request courses: Meet with your counselor by January 24th to choose your courses.
- 6 Semester Grad Apps due February 14th
- C9 Applications due January 31st
- Course request Changes through May 1st
 - These deadlines are important. There will be no exceptions!

Central 9

- Must be on track to graduate to attend C9
- Online Application
- If you complete an application, you have committed to attend C9.
- We do not allow students to drop any class, including C9, after May 1st.
