

BUDGET SURPLUS



- D) Permanently reduce taxes




How would you rate access to health care in your community?


5. Should Indiana require high school students to take a financial literacy course covering topics such as setting a personal budget and long-term saving?








7. Would you support or oppose a law that limits how long a local government can impose a food and beverage tax?


