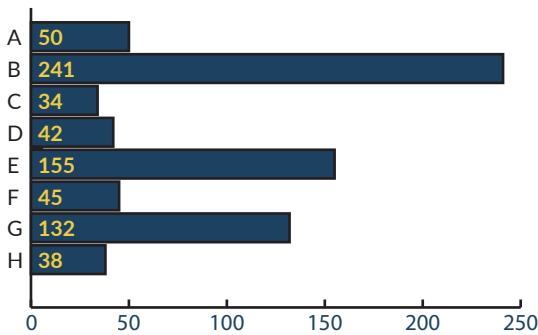

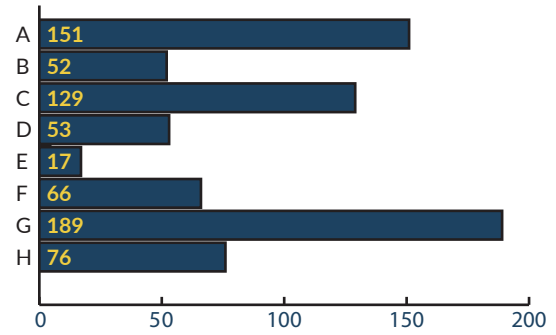

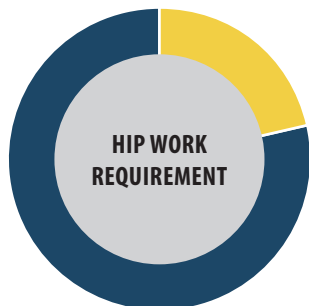
2. Which one of the following is the most important for me to focus on as your state senator?

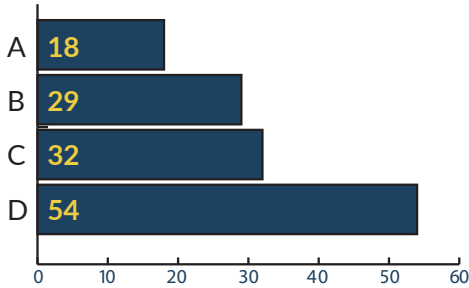

KIDS ATTENDING SCHOOL

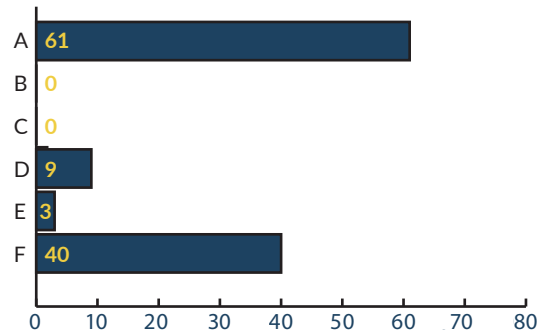
