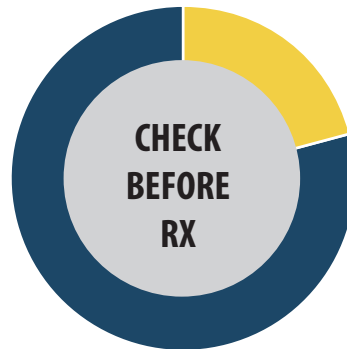
3. Should a person be required to pay a fee and undergo a background check in order to get a permit to carry a handgun in public?

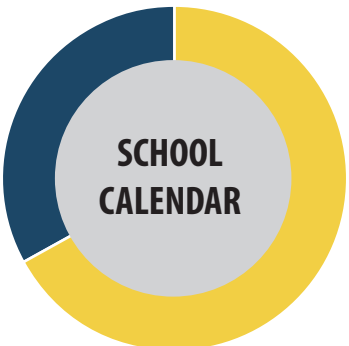
4. In order to limit prescription drug abuse, should doctors be required to check a patient's prescription history before issuing a new prescription?

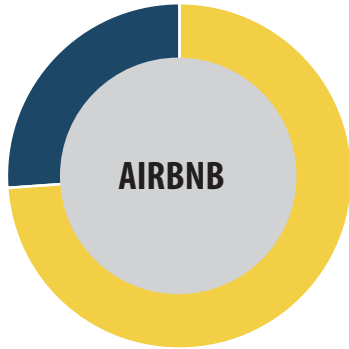

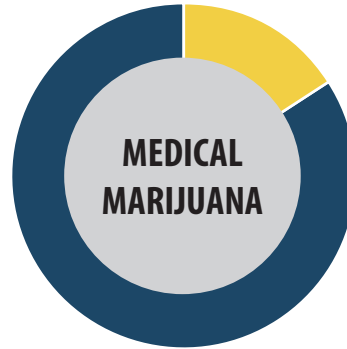
- 7.** Should local governments be able to restrict homeowners from renting out their property with short-term rental services like Airbnb?

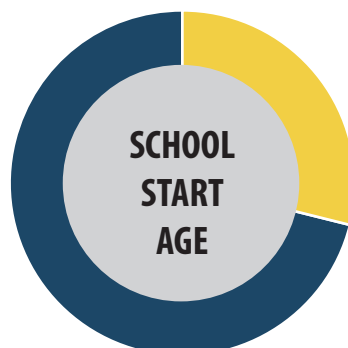
- 10.** Should illegal immigrants who were brought to the United States as children be eligible to receive the same in-state college tuition rate as legal Indiana residents?
