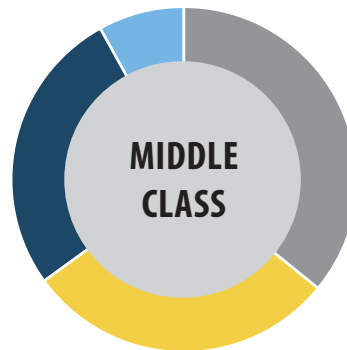

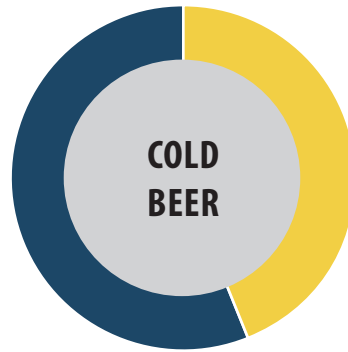

**7.** Do you support or oppose the sale of alcohol in licensed retail stores on Sundays, which is currently prohibited in Indiana?



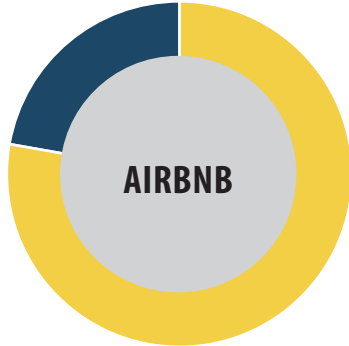

**8.** Do you support or oppose allowing licensed retail stores, including gas stations, to sell cold beer for carryout? (This is currently limited to liquor stores.)



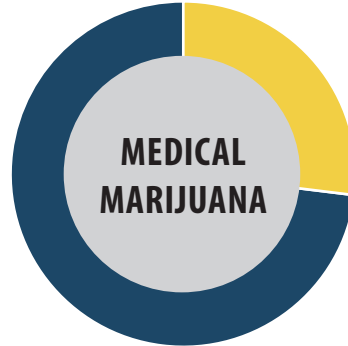
