Heartsaver CPR/AED

The Heartsaver CPR Course teaches lay rescuers how to recognize and treat life-threatening emergencies, including cardiac arrest and choking for adult, child and infant victims. Students also learn to recognize the warning signs of heart attack and stroke in adults and breathing difficulties in children. The program is divided into a choice of three different courses. Heartsaver CPR for All Ages teaches CPR and relief of foreign-body airway obstruction in the adult, the infant, and the child.

Hands-Only CPR teaches rescuers basic chest compressions to give confidence plus basic knowledge of cardiac maintenance until EMS arrives.

Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Providers

Basic Life Support (BLS) for Healthcare Provider is designed to teach the skills of CPR for victims of all ages, including ventilation with a barrier device, a bag-mask device, use of an automated external defibrillator (AED) and relief of foreign body airway obstruction (FBAO). It is intended for participants who provide health care to patients in a wide variety of settings, including in-hospital and out-of-hospital settings.

*This course is designed for Healthcare Providers such as physicians, nurses, paramedics, emergency medical technicians, respiratory therapists, physical and occupational therapists, physician's assistants, nursing students in training, aides, medical or nursing assistants, dental assistants and other allied health personnel.
