



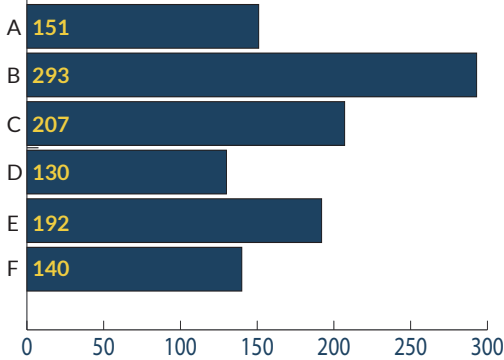

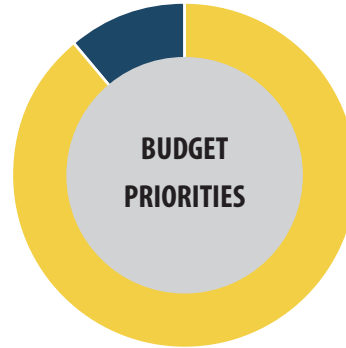
1. When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

- F) Other



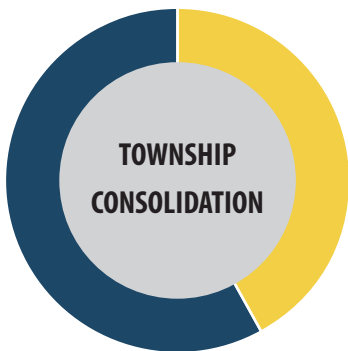

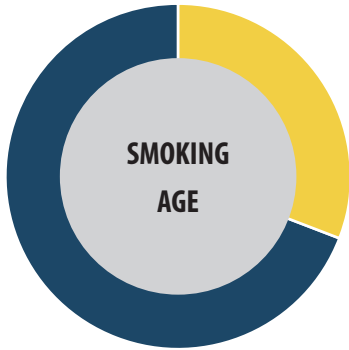
