




When the legislature adopts a new state budget during the 2019 session, which one of the following do you think should be the top priority?

#### **BUDGET PRIORITES**


- A) Addiction treatment to address the drug epidemic


Do you support or oppose requiring townships with fewer than 1,000 residents to consolidate in order to make local government more efficient?




Should Indiana require able-bodied adults to work or look for work in order to receive publicly funded healthcare coverage under the Healthy Indiana Plan?
