


2020 SURVEY RESULTS


STATE SENATOR ANDY ZAY

- 2 Should Indiana offer foster children the opportunity to choose where they go to school to help increase their success of graduating high school?






- With nearly 25% of Hoosiers having sub-prime credit, should high school students have to take a financial literacy program as a graduation requirement?


