

VISITATION POLICY

Beginning September 3, 2020, the visitation policy is updated as follows:

COVID UNIT: Patients diagnosed with COVID-19 will have no visitors except for End of Life or special circumstances approved by the CEO, CNO, or Nursing Supervisor.

INPATIENTS: (visiting hours: 7:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m.)

- ALL visitors age 18 or older must be screened for Covid-19 symptoms upon arrival at Main Entrance and/or every 24-hours at the Main Entrance. (Before 7:30 a.m. and after 7:30 p.m. report to Emergency Department entrance for screening.) Visitors will be given a badge, to be updated every 24-hours if needed, to wear throughout visit. Visitors will be logged in for tracking purposes on the unit.
- Visitors are required to bring and wear their own face covering/mask.

Medical/Surgical Unit, Critical Care Unit/Progressive Care Unit
One visitor allowed during visiting hours.

Maternity Center

One designated visitor allowed throughout visit. (No limitation on visiting hours but you cannot leave the building between 7:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m.)

OUTPATIENTS:

- ALL visitors must be screened for Covid-19 symptoms upon arrival at all entrances.
- Visitors are required to bring and wear their own face covering/mask.

Emergency Department

One designated visitor allowed throughout visit.

Surgery

One designated visitor allowed. If patient is a minor, one legal guardian is allowed. Visitor must first report to Surgery Entrance to be screened for Covid-19 symptoms. Visitor will be given a badge, to be updated every 24-hours if needed, to wear throughout visit.

Johnson Memorial Physician Office and Services Visits:

- Women's Health Office: One visitor allowed for ultrasound visit. One visitor if patient needs assistance. No children may accompany adult appointments.
- Orthopedics & Surgical Specialists Office: One visitor if patient needs assistance. If patient is a minor, one legal guardian is allowed. No children may accompany adult appointments.
- Internal Medicine and Family Medicine Offices: One visitor if patient needs assistance. No children may accompany adult appointments.
- Pediatrics Office: One legal guardian is allowed. Limit additional children-please make this arrangement prior to the office visit.
- Other Outpatient Services: One visitor if patient needs assistance.
