All students at NHJ have an individual prepaid cafeteria account and a PIN (personal identification number). Cafeteria account deposits may be made by cash or check or made online. Make checks payable to NHJ Schools. Deposits may be made weekly or monthly and **must be made in advance of purchases**. Deposits may be applied to each student's prepaid cafeteria account at any school. To send a payment with your student, place payment in an envelope with the following information:

- Student(s) name(s)
- Grade
- Amount enclosed
- Amount to be applied to each student's account.

Meal prices for this school year will be posted on the school website.

If you think you may qualify for free or reduced priced meals and you do not receive a letter during the summer stating that your child has already qualified for assistance for the 21-22 school year, please complete and return a Free/Reduced Price Meal Application before school starts if possible. Complete one application per household. Applications will be available the second week of July and will be posted on the school website. Print, complete, and take completed application to the administration office or your child's school or mail to: Food Service Department, NHJ Administration Office, 802 S Indian Creek Drive, Trafalgar, IN 46181. Applications will be processed and letters mailed stating if your child/children qualify for assistance.
