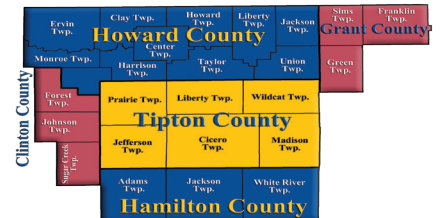
BIOGRAPHY

Indiana State Sen. Jim Buck has served Hoosiers in Senate District 21, which includes all of Howard and Tipton counties and portions of Clinton, Grant and Hamilton counties, since 2008. Previously, Buck served in the Indiana House of Representatives from 1994 to 2008.

Buck is the Chair of the Senate Committee on Local Government and National Chair of the American Legislative Exchange Council. He also serves on the Senate Committees on Civil Law and Tax and Fiscal Policy.

Buck holds two bachelor's degrees and a Master of Business Administration degree from Indiana Wesleyan University. In addition to Buck's work as a legislator, he is the Vice President of the We Care Board, serves on the Learning Network Board, and is a member of the Rotary Club and Mason Lodge No. 93.
