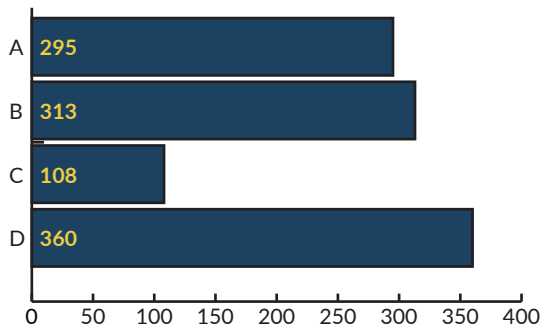

BUDGET SURPLUS

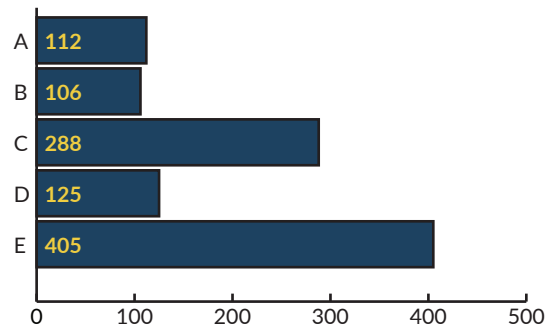
- A) Return money directly to taxpayers through a one-time payment

IMPROVE K-12 EDUCATION

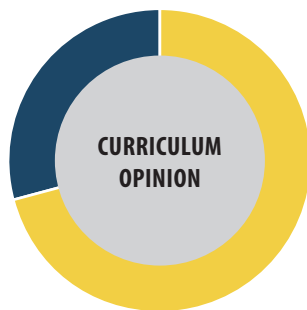
- A) Continue to increase funding
