The library will pay up to \$400 annually for Staci's life insurance and will match up to 7% of her gross wage/salary contributions to the library's 457 retirement savings plan, administered currently through Edward Jones. This motion to adopt was made by Michael Morris.

 - E. Beth Roberts will contact Staci Treece extend the offer of employment.
- V. Request for Authorization to Make HVAC Repair
 - A. The HVAC system in the Jenkins Meeting Room is broken. The board was provided with an estimate for the repair by the Dilling Group (Exhibit 2). It took 9 hours for the contractor to come up with this estimate. We need a new expansion valve in the air handler. The valve is in a tight spot and will require cutting into the area to repair. They are estimating it will take 8 hours to complete the

repair. We will need some new refrigerant. Mike Bloom said the technicians seemed knowledgeable, and he would recommend hiring them. They will do a pressure check. Part of the problem is that our equipment is undersized for the area it covers. Mike again emphasized that he has confidence in this company.
