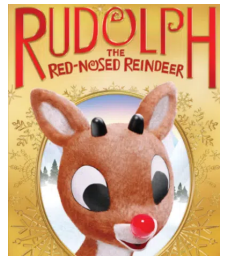

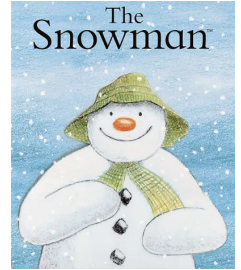
4. Frosty the Snowman (1969)

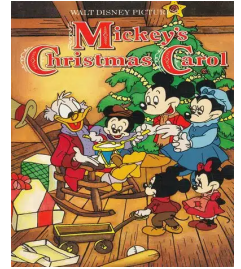
5.The Snowman (1982)

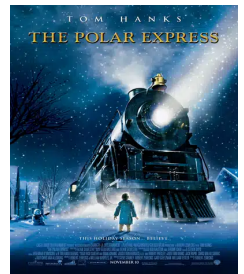
6. Mickey's Christmas Carol (1983)
