

Facilitating the School of Fraternity Practices

Thank you for your interest in being a facilitator for the 41st School of Fraternity Practices. Theta Chi's Biennial event is scheduled to take place August 2, 2024 in New Orleans, LA at the New Orleans Marriott Canal Street.

The School of Fraternity Practices is a leadership and chapter operations school held in conjunction with the International Convention. The School of Fraternity Practices will offer educational training to chapter members, colony members, and alumni through breakout sessions scheduled throughout Convention weekend. These breakout sessions are run by volunteers, such as you.

The Resolute Man Event Track:

If you apply and are selected to serve as faculty for our Resolute Man Event in New Orleans, you will need to arrive on August 1, 2024. Programming for the event will start that evening.

Facilitator Expectations:

- Arrive at the hotel before 4 p.m. CST on Friday, August 2 (Thursday, August 1 if serving on The Resolute Man Event Track)
- Most of our preparation will be done prior to arrival, but there will be a facilitator training the morning of Saturday, August 3
- · You will facilitate three or more sessions as assigned by International Headquarters
- Be present for all general sessions and Convention events throughout the weekend
- Set the example by enjoying your free time in New Orleans responsibly
- Depart at your leisure any time on or after Tuesday, August 6

Travel & Compensation:

- Travel to New Orleans is at your own expense
- Hotel stay for four nights at the New Orleans Marriott Canal Street will be provided. (Five nights are covered if you are serving as faculty for The Resolute Man Event Track)
- Meals are provided from dinner on the evening that you arrive through dinner on August 5
- Registration costs for all sessions is covered by International Headquarters

What You'll be Facilitating:

- Assignments will be based on topic selections submitted in your application
- You will be expected to create the outline for your assigned topic (learning objectives, presentation, activity guide, handouts, etc.)
- A staff member will assist you with Theta Chi branding and collaboration of your outline and presentation

Application Process:

- Applications must be submitted by Friday, March 22 to be considered
- Notifications of final selections will be sent out by the end of business on Friday, April 19

For every School of Fraternity Practices, we receive an extraordinary amount of interest in facilitating and can only select a small number of applicants. We cannot thank you enough for demonstrating your desire to perpetuate Theta Chi's ideals.
