As summer school winds down this week, I wanted to share some updates with you regarding the 2021-22 school year calendar. These changes are as follows:

- Online Registration Starts July 13.
- We will also host an in-person registration at the High School Cafeteria on July 28, from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. for anyone who was not able to register online. All school building offices will reopen on July 26 for those who need additional support with the registration process.
- The Vocational student start day has been changed from August 4 to August 9.
- We have added two eLearning days on September 15 and 16 for elementary students only.
  These days will permit our elementary staff to attend professional development on Trust-Based
  Relational Interventions that has been funded through a grant from the United Way of
  Whitewater Valley. Middle School and High School students will be attending in person on these
  days.
- We have added two eLearning days on January 12 and 13 for middle school and high school students only. These days will permit our middle school and high school staff to attend professional development on Trust-Based Relational Interventions that has been funded through a grant from the United Way of Whitewater Valley. Elementary students will be attending in person on these days.

These updated calendar changes can be found on the <u>calendar posted on our school website</u>.

Additionally, we have been continuing to monitor the COVID-19 status for the state, our county, and our schools. As of July 1, 2021, Governor Holcomb will not be extending the executive order for schools regarding COVID-19 requirements. In conjunction with the Union County Health Department, we believe that our students and staff can safely return to school with no restrictions. Students and staff still have the option to wear a face mask if they prefer. As has been the practice with the pandemic, we will monitor the cases in our schools and county and make necessary adjustments and communicate these changes.
