


1. Should Indiana legalize marijuana for medical use?


4. Hoosiers currently must register about a month before Election Day in order to vote. Should the law be changed so you can both register and vote on Election Day?


5. Indiana schools currently set their own calendars. Should schools be prohibited from starting classes before the last Monday in August?


**8.** Do you support or oppose allowing licensed retail stores, including gas stations, to sell cold beer for carryout? (This is currently limited to liquor stores.)


**9.** Do you think criminals should receive longer sentences if they committed their crime because of prejudice against a specific trait of the victim such as race, religion or gender?


**10.** Should a person be required to pay a fee and undergo a background check in order to get a permit to carry a handgun in public?
