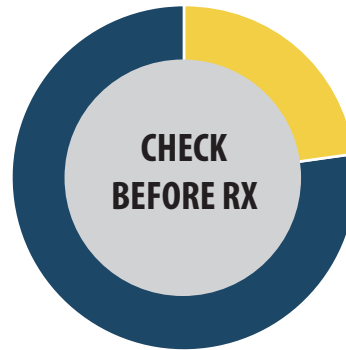
- 1.** Do you think criminals should receive longer sentences if they committed their crime because of prejudice against a specific trait of the victim such as race, religion or gender?
