FRANKLIN, Ind. – The Friends of Johnson County Public Library are pleased to present an antiques and collectibles appraisal fundraising event featuring author and antiques expert Mark F. Moran.

Have you ever wondered how much that antique dish is worth? Have collectibles that you are thinking of selling? Find out what they're worth at the Friends Annual Event at the Franklin Branch Oct. 27 at 1 p.m.

Appraisals are open to JCPL cardholders for a \$10 fee (payable by cash or check.) Please make checks out to Friends of Johnson County Public Library. Registration and payment are required at the time of registration. Register in person at any Branch or at the Library Services Center.

Registration is on a first come basis and appraisal of items is limited to 40 items total, one per person. Registration remains open until all 40 slots are filled.

Excluded items include all weapons, including swords and knives (though folding knives with advertising are accepted), traps (like leg-hold), Nazi memorabilia, coins and paper money, fine jewelry, including precious gems and Beanie Babies.

Moran bought and sold antiques for more than 30 years, specializing in vintage folk art, Americana and fine art. He is the author or co-author of more than 25 books on antiques and collectibles, including three editions of the 800-page annual "Warman's Antiques & Collectibles."

General admission for viewing is at no cost and is open to the public. The public is encouraged to drop in for all or part of the evening. Light refreshments will be provided.
