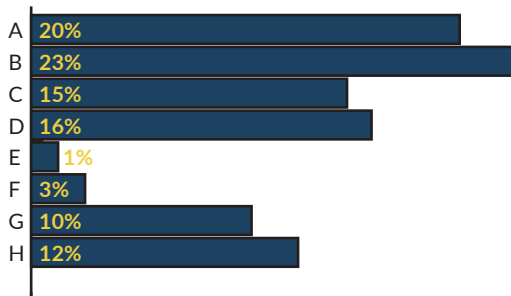

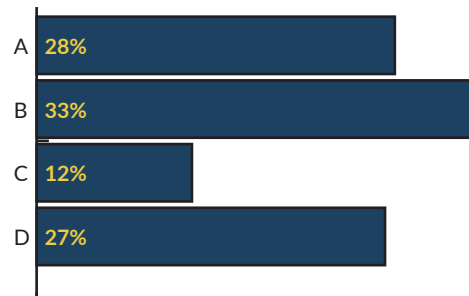

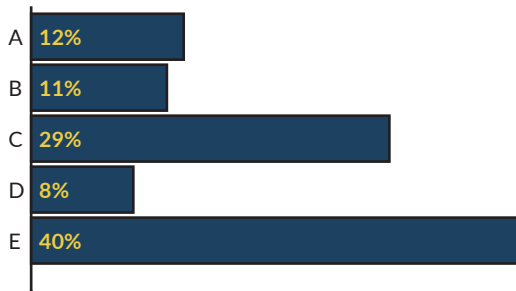

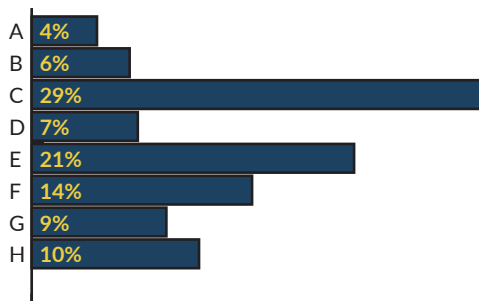

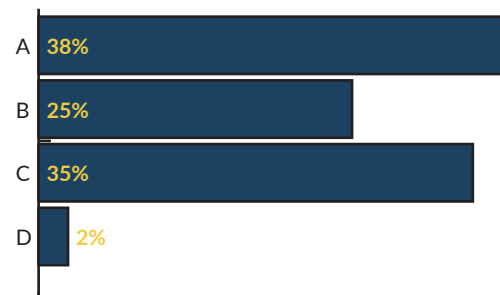

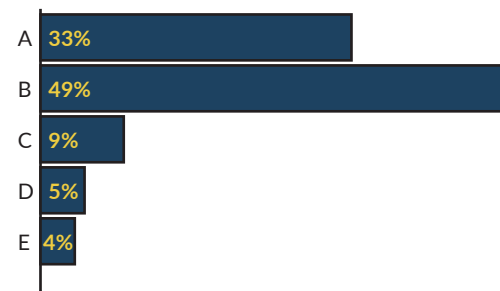

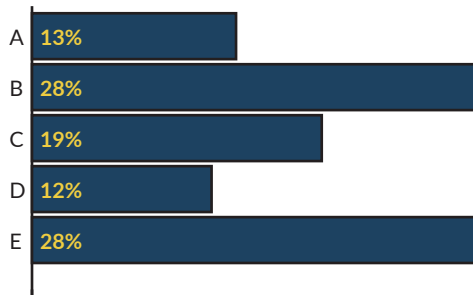

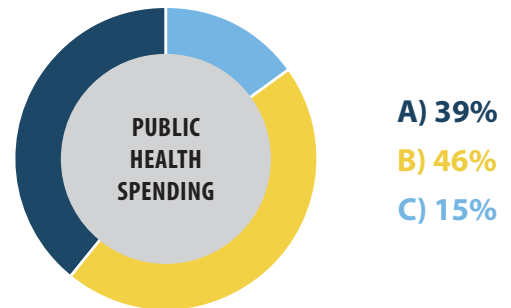

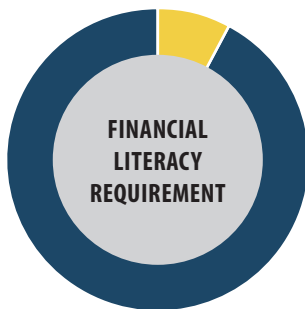
10. Which of the following reflects your opinion on public health spending in Indiana?

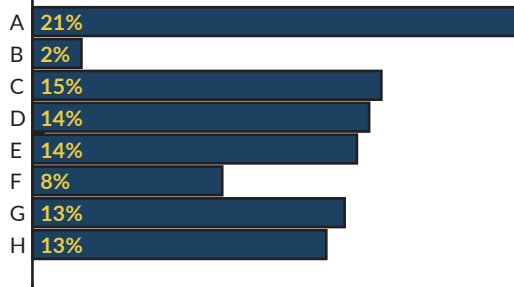

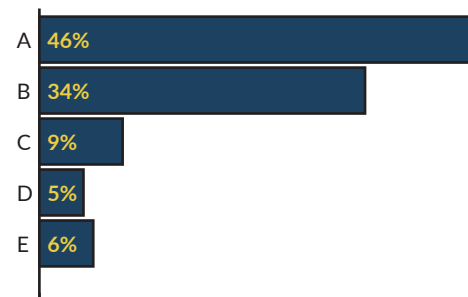

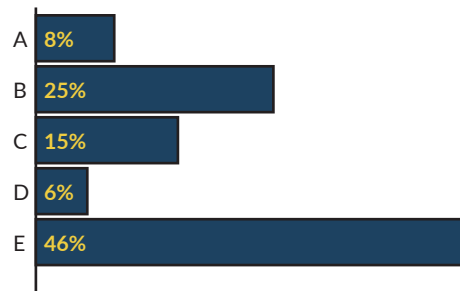
