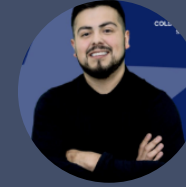

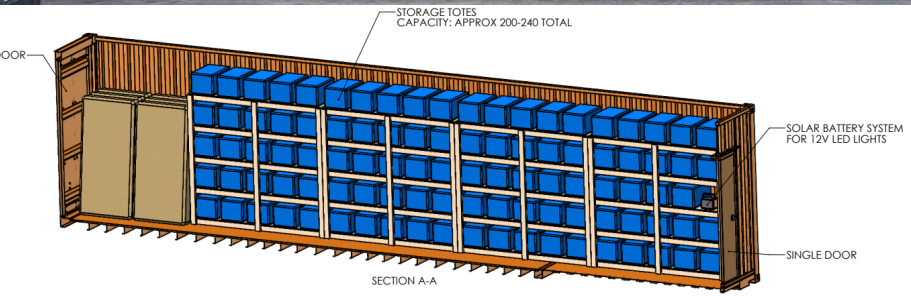

Stupendous Storage Solutions

for Resources of Hope

A major challenge for Resources of Hope was turning away critical donations to support foster and kinship youth due to limited space at their facility in Whiteland, IN. Now they will not have to do that!

Targets & Outcomes

In 2023, RoH Served 1437 kids. We hope to increase that impact and reach by 800 kids this year together with Resources of Hope and our partners.

Secured a 40' Shipping Container with lighting, a solar generator, shelves and containers, and had it delivered to RoH.

50+ Hours of Planning

Planning in-process to continue the project with a community mural event with Foster and Kinship Families.

This project will be a success, when the storage solution is delivered, everything is unpacked and kids are able to "shop" around.

Increase Capacity of Support by 64%

- Allows for larger donations
- Store off season items
- Enables RoH strategic mobile initiative
- Allow for storage of beds, cribs and car seats
- +320sf additional storage
- No longer have to turn donations away!
- Free up space storage space for programming
