State Sen. Justin Busch was appointed to the Indiana State Senate in 2018. He represents Senate District 16, which includes portions of Allen and Whitley counties.

Busch serves as a member of the Senate Committees on Agriculture; Corrections and Criminal Law; Health and Provider Services; and Natural Resources.

Prior to his appointment, he worked for the George W. Bush administration and was appointed to the Indiana State Real Estate Commission by former Gov. Mike Pence. Additionally, he served as an at-large member of the Allen County Council.

Busch attended Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne, where he received a bachelor's degree in interpersonal and organizational communication from Purdue University and a bachelor's degree in history from Indiana University.

He currently serves as a Brightpoint board member and is a lifetime member of the NRA.

Busch resides in Fort Wayne.
