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5 WHEREAS, it is central to a physician's practice that orders including prescriptions be carried out in a
6 timely manner, and

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8 WHEREAS, as of recent shortages of prescription medications has made it difficult for patients to
9 receive their medications in a timely manner, and

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11 WHEREAS, pharmacies have been unwilling to transfer prescriptions, therefore be it

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13 RESOLVED, that the Indiana Academy of Family Physicians (IAFP) send a letter to the Indiana
14 Attorney General's Office requesting that an emergency resolution be requested to allow and mandate
15 that Indiana pharmacies are required to transfer a prescription (including controlled substances) to
16 another pharmacy whenever the prescribed medication is unavailable at the pharmacy.
