



Go on a Bug Hunt

Take a walk outside and see what insects or spiders you have around your house. Bring a camera or magnifying glass. Look under rocks, on trees, on plants, or in dark spots around your house. Just be sure to observe and not disturb or touch!

Make your own Stick Insect

Supplies: Sticks, Leaves, Hot Glue, Tape, Thread, Paint

Directions:

- When gathering sticks try to think about the different parts of the insects that you need
- Hot glue will create the most realistic look, but feel free to use whatever you have on hand
- Once you have the body assembled paint or decorate to achieve your desired look
- Take pictures with your Stick Insect

Create your Own Insect

If you could create your own insect what would it be?

All insects must have:

- Head
- 2 antennae
- Compound Eyes
- Thorax (central portion of the body)
- 6 legs
- Wings (if it can fly)
- Abdomen (the ball typically seen on many insects)

Don't forget to consider the insect's habitat (where it lives), what it eats, and how it protects itself from predators. Feel free to share your creation with us at the library!
