Michael's main motivation for wanting a job is the independence that comes with earning money. While this may be true, Lori says she has seen a lot of other positive side effects since he started working in late July. "I think it has given him a lot of confidence. It occupies his mind and makes him feel

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She stated that Michael feels comfortable asking his manager for more tasks when he has completed his work, and that he has learned to speak up and advocate for himself, such as when he noticed his coworkers all had visors on and he had been given a baseball cap. Knowing that he would be more comfortable in a visor in the summer heat, he asked his manager if he could get one. The manager told him that they were on backorder, but that he would be sure to give Michael a visor as soon as they arrived.

Right now, Michael's role is completing outdoor maintenance, but since he is a quick learner, he has started learning other tasks, and may eventually move into other roles. "When I reminded Michael of a task I thought he had overlooked and commented to him about it, his reply to me was, 'I know...I've got this.'" said Lori.



Though Michael has experience as a volunteer, you can tell that finding employment has buoyed his spirits and given him a boost in self-esteem. He's grateful, too, that Wendy's gave him an opportunity, and typed his supervisor a thank-you note to show how much the opportunity means to him.
