



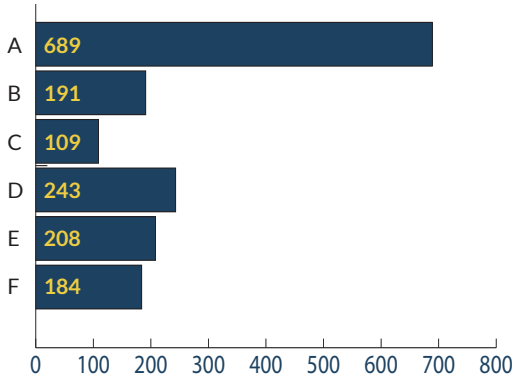

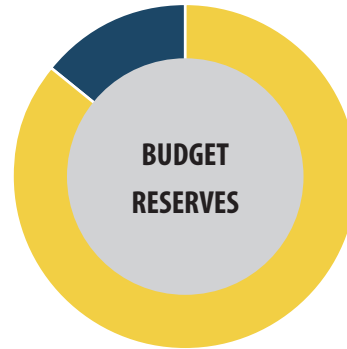

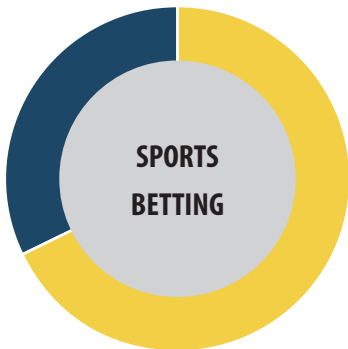
- A) K-12 schools (51%)

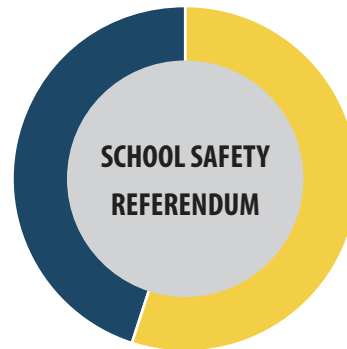
**3.** Do you support or oppose legalizing sports betting in Indiana?

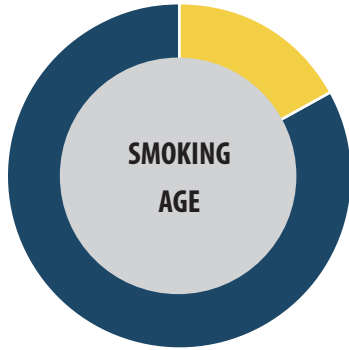

**6.** The minimum legal age to buy cigarettes in Indiana is currently 18. Do you support or oppose raising the smoking age to 21?



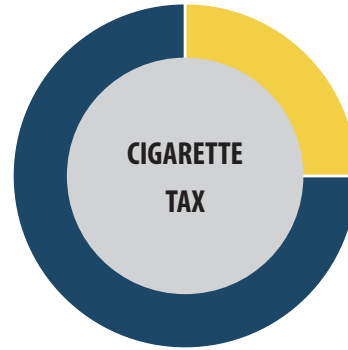

**7.** Do you support or oppose raising Indiana's cigarette tax by \$2.00 per pack in order to deter smoking and pay for health programs?



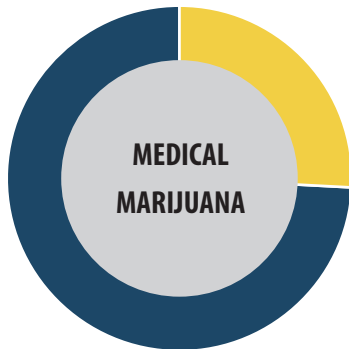
