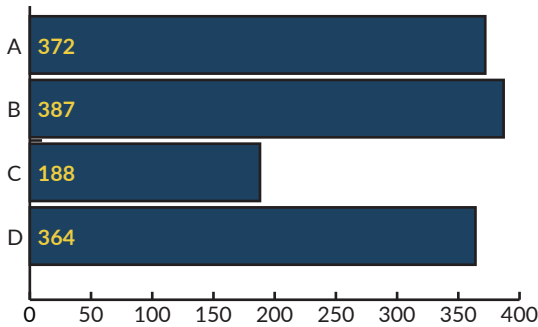

BUDGET SURPLUS

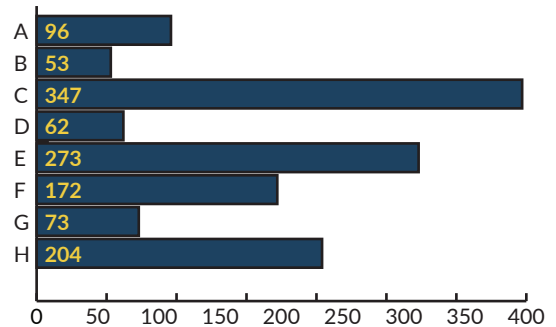
- A) Return money directly to taxpayers through a one-time payment

- H) Road funding



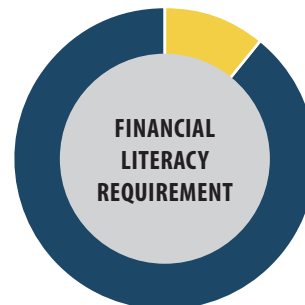
3. Do you support or oppose allowing the Attorney General to prosecute crimes if a local prosecutor refuses to do so?
