- How do you usually respond to correction?
- In what ways do you think wisdom and understanding are connected to our relationship with Jesus?
- This week's message mentioned three important practical actions: submit, adjust, and obey. Which of those three is toughest for you? How have you seen Jesus show up when you put one of those into practice?
