


The following charts represent responses to the multiple-choice questions offered on my mailed and online survey. Answers to open-ended questions are not included here.

**3.** Should Indiana change our high school diploma requirements so students can do more on-the-job learning and spend less time in a classroom?




5. If a prosecutor categorically refuses to charge certain crimes, should the state give a special prosecutor the authority to enforce Indiana's laws in that county?
