BIOGRAPHY

State Sen. Justin Busch has represented northeastern Indiana in the Senate since 2018. He serves Senate District 16, which includes Whitley County and a portion of Allen County.

Busch serves as Assistant Caucus Chair and is ranking member of the Senate Committee on Health and Provider Services. He also serves on the Senate Committees on Appropriations and Public Policy.

Prior to serving in the Senate, Busch worked for the George W. Bush administration and was appointed to the Indiana State Real Estate Commission by former Gov. Mike Pence. Additionally, he served as an at-large member of the Allen County Council.

Busch attended Indiana University-Purdue University Fort Wayne, where he received a bachelor's degree in interpersonal and organizational communication from Purdue University and a bachelor's degree in history from Indiana University.

Outside of the Senate, Busch serves as Vice President of Fort Wayne Garmong Construction.
