Delta Upsilon International Fraternity is excited to welcome you to the 2026 Presidents Academy. This memo is intended to make your travels to Indianapolis and Camp Tecumseh as smooth and enjoyable as possible. Please print this letter and bring it with you.

Travel Information – Arrival

If you are flying into Indianapolis International Airport (IND):

- Please complete the travel information/reimbursement form with your flight details by Friday, December 12, 2025 via the Delta Upsilon Portal
- **All flights must arrive into IND by 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 8, 2026**
- Upon exiting the aircraft, please follow the signs to the main terminal and baggage claim.
- Delta Upsilon staff members (pictured left to right) CJ Gibson, Axel Hoge, Nam Vu, Trey McDonald will greet you in the main terminal near McDonalds – if you checked bags, please check in with the staff members first then proceed down the escalator to baggage claim.



- You will need to eat dinner prior to arriving at the camp.
- Flight delays/cancellations – please call CJ Gibson at 309-532-7422

If you are driving to Camp Tecumseh:

- **Plan accordingly in order to arrive at camp by 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, January 8, 2026**
- The camp is located approximately 80 miles northwest of Indianapolis near Purdue University
- Once you arrive on site, follow the signs to Lake Village and park in the lot adjacent to the Kampen Lodge
- Please plan to eat dinner before arriving to Camp.
- Once you check in, you will not be permitted to leave camp.
- Car keys will be collected and labeled at the registration desk.

Travel Information – Departure

If you fly out of Indianapolis International Airport (IND):

- All flights must depart IND after 1:00 p.m. on Sunday, January 11, 2026
- Bus transportation will be provided back to the airport, departing camp at 10:00 a.m.
- **No transportation will be available for earlier flights.**

If you are driving:

- You will be permitted to depart camp after 10:00 a.m. on Sunday, January 11, 2026

What to Wear/What to Pack

The attire for the Presidents Academy is casual. Jeans, sweatshirts, and sweaters are appropriate. Temperatures will likely be in the 20s and 30s, so please pack accordingly. Layers are recommended. Be sure to pack/wear a heavy coat and closed toe shoes as there will be some outdoor activities.

Packing list:

- Bath towel and wash cloth – bedding will be provided, but towels will not.
- Cash – for dinner at the airport and any extras
- Cell phone and charger
- Photo identification (and passport, if traveling from Canada)
- Extra chapter t-shirts to exchange with brothers.
- Toiletries and shower shoes
- Health insurance card – in case of an emergency, please bring information regarding your personal health insurance.

Housing

All participants will be housed in cabins. Bedding will be provided (sheets, blanket, and pillow) and the cabins are heated; however, you may want to bring an extra blanket. Please pack your own bath towel and wash cloth, as they will not be provided.

Please note: Camp Tecumseh and Delta Upsilon Presidents Academy is an alcohol and substance-free facility and program.

Time Zone

Indianapolis and Camp Tecumseh are in the Eastern Standard Time Zone.

Travel Reimbursement

All Presidents Academy participants will be reimbursed for travel from their home chapter/associate chapter (up to the pre-determined amount). Reimbursement will be made after January 15, 2026 in the form of a chapter credit.

The chapter is responsible for issuing any refunds that are due to an individual member.

Flying:

- You must provide a copy of your itinerary/receipt to IHQ before reimbursement will be given. For reimbursement, fill out the travel information and reimbursement form found on the Delta Upsilon Portal.
- The maximum reimbursement amount per person is determined by a four-week advance ticket purchase, with participant traveling from the closest major airport of the chapter/associate chapter. This does not mean you have to travel from the chapter/associate chapter location to receive reimbursement, but this is the location used to determine the reimbursement limit.

- If you will have to arrive on Wednesday, January 7, 2026, please contact Noah Borton at 317-875-8900 or borton@deltatau.org before making any travel arrangements.

Driving:

- If your chapter/associate chapter location is approximately a six-hour drive or less from Brookston, IN, you will be expected to drive.
- The cap for mileage reimbursement is set at the round-trip mileage from your chapter/associate chapter location to Camp Tecumseh.
- Mileage is reimbursed at 25 cents per mile.
- For reimbursement, fill out the travel form on the Delta Upsilon Portal

Inclement Weather Plan

- This outline explains Delta Upsilon's planned response to a weather-related emergency.
- A weather-related emergency is defined as severe or inclement weather that has the potential to disrupt the travel or operation of the Presidents Academy. Examples include snow, ice, severe cold, or flooding.
- DU plans to hold the Presidents Academy. If we must cancel due to extreme winter weather, we will not reschedule.
- In the case of cancellation, we will send participants the workbook and program materials and conduct online training in the spring.

Response Categories:

If inclement weather occurs and has the potential to disrupt the Presidents Academy, one of two response categories will be implemented as appropriate:

- Delayed start – the program will have a delayed start to accommodate the safe arrival of participants
- Program cancelled – a decision will be made by 4:00 p.m., if inclement weather the day of the program start dictates cancellation

Notifications:

- DU will notify all participants via text message and email of any schedule changes or cancellations.
- DU will update its website with any schedule changes or cancellations.

Accommodations:

- DU will assist participants in securing hotel accommodations near the Indianapolis International Airport if air travel is disrupted.
