What we do

Timmy works to provide continuity in the community sites we visit by placing different universities/service trip teams into our international clinics on a rotating basis—every 2-3 months, throughout the year.

This makes it possible to follow up with critical care patients, treat chronic conditions, and increase the overall quality, sustainability, and impact of our short-term medical clinics.

A Day at Clinic

- Medical professionals assist in various support roles throughout clinic:
 - TRIAGE
 - Vital signs, patient histories, and lab tests including but not limited to: blood glucose, UTI, pregnancy
 - Nurses help in this station
 - PATIENT CONSULTATION
 - Partners from the Dominican communities will serve as translators
 - IUPUI student volunteers will serve as medical scribes
 - Medical Practitioners such as MD, DO, PA, or NPs work in this station
 - PHARMACY
 - Checking prescriptions and helping dispense medications
 - Pharmacists and nurses help in this station

What to expect

- It is helpful to know in advance that life is a serious struggle in these communities due to lack of social services and low wages and while it may be difficult to witness the impoverished living conditions.
- Keep in mind that Timmy, our partner Shoulder to Shoulder, and others are taking serious steps to lessen the disparities throughout this area.
- You will be part of a committed team making a difference!
